Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- The title of the Manuscript must be clear, concise and in alignment with the theme.
- The extended abstract should contain 1000 to 1500 words.
- The extended abstract must include Title, Author(s), and Affiliation, Introduction, Methodology, Findings, Conclusion, Implications, 5-7 Keywords and Key References.
- Extended abstracts must be in Times New Roman, 12-point font, single-spaced with 1-inch margin all around.
- The title page must contain the title, author's name, name of the corresponding author, author's affiliation and contact details.
- Accepted extended abstracts will be published in the proceedings/edited book by a reputed, international Bloomsbury publishing house. The book will have an ISBN number.

Full Paper Submission Guidelines

- Full Manuscript should not exceed 5000 words
- Manuscripts should be aligned with the theme and tracks of the Conference
- Manuscripts must be written in APA 7th edition formatting style
- The cover page of the Manuscript should include the title of the Manuscript, the name(s) of the author(s), their affiliation(s), and contact details
- Manuscripts must be in Times New Roman, 12-point font, double spaced with 1-inch margin all around
- Each Manuscript will undergo a standard process of review by experts, after which the authors will

be notified.


